Richard was described by the Independent on Sunday as “one of Britain’s leading specialists” in the field of abuse law.

During his career he has acted for victims in the North Wales child abuse inquiry and represented clients in many cases against the Catholic Church and other organisations.

He has achieved many landmark personal injury compensation settlements for clients, including record settlements of £640,000 and £538,000 for children abused in care.

Richard currently represents young women involved in the sexual exploitation scandal in Rochdale and victims of the publicist Max Clifford.

Richard was one of the founders of ACAL (Association of Child Abuse Lawyers) and has written extensively on the subject of abuse.

His book Betrayed: The English Catholic Church and the Sex Abuse Crisis was published in 2014 and Richard also co-authored the APIL Guide to Child Abuse Compensation Claims published in 2011.
